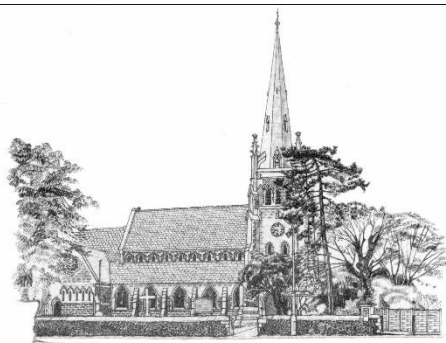

Prayer Group

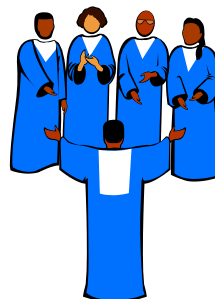
**Open to all and every Sunday after
